Madina Foundation is a non-profit charity organization approved under Section 2(36) of the Income Tax Ordinance 2001, Government of Pakistan. The Foundation is dedicated to serving humanity in various sectors, including health and education. In addition, the Foundation is running various non profit projects for the welfare and social uplift of the community. Madina Foundation was registered on 11 October 1999 in the office of Sub Registrar Rawalpindi with the Mission, alleviation of unemployment and poverty irrespective of religion, cast, color, gender or creed and Provide economic relief and empowerment to the underprivileged cross section of the society. The main objective of foundation is to earn and spend for the welfare of deserving peoples. The foundation declared net surplus of Rs.2.59 M as on June 30, 2022. The Board's role was instrumental in steering the foundation forward in a challenging environment whilst discharging its statutory responsibilities for the benefit of general public. The Board has remained cognizant throughout the year of its strategic role for achieving the Company's key objectives and on enhancing the benefits for the deserving society of the country. - 1. Fire prevention/fighting training by 1122.** Under the auspices of Madina Foundation the Management of The University of Faisalabad regularly arranges special training sessions for its faculty members, students and staff on how to deal with emergencies like a terrorist attack, fir incident, or some other natural calamity.

A “Fire prevention/fighting training” session was held in collaboration with Rescue 1122 in Health Sciences Wing on January 5, 2022. Mr Muzammil Hussain, Senior Instructor from Rescue 1122 and Mr Mujahid Ali, Fire Fighter Officer, TUF conducted the session.

In his lecture, Mr Muzammil gave general awareness about fire prevention/fighting techniques and use of equipment. Orientation on various types of fire extinguishers and equipment was also given by him. Later, mock drill/practical exercises of firefighting were performed by the participants. Faculty members, staff and security personnel of the University actively participated in all the exercises and thanked the University Management particularly the Rescue 1122 for conducting such a useful training.





2. **Seminar “Women Empowerment”**. A seminar captioned "Women Empowerment" was conducted under the supervision of Dr Arshia Hashmi, Head department of Management Studies in Health Sciences wing on February 4, 2022.

### 4. The University of Faisalabad renews MoU with Drug Advisory Training Hub for Drug Control.

Under the umbrella of Madina Foundation, The University of Faisalabad (TUF) has been declared as smoke and drug free Institution, three years ago by the Drug Advisory Training Hub (DATH), a non-government organization working on abuse of drugs. In this context, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was renewed between both the institutions witnessed by Mr Zahid Hussain, Commissioner Faisalabad division and Mr Muhammad Haider Amin, Chairman Board of Governors TUF. Syed Zulfiqar Hussain Consultant Anti Drug/Narcotics, Chairman DATH and Ms Zahida Maqbool, Additional Registrar, TUF signed the agreement. The agreement was renewed with aim to restrain youngsters from the consumption of drugs which is increasing at an alarming pace.

On this occasion an awareness seminar on “Drug abuse prevention among youth” was also organized in Mukhtar Auditorium of the University. Mr Imran Baloch, Director Focus Rehabilitation, Syed Mohsin, Coordinator Education Program (DATH), Heads of Departments, faculty members and large number of students attended the seminar. Addressing the audience Mr Zahid Hussain, Commissioner said that new trend of drug addiction are increasing among the youth particularly students which is an alarming situation. He said that the government is fully aware of the gravity of the problem and we are making all efforts to control drug menace in the society. Commissioner also appreciated the efforts of the University Management under the auspices of Madinah Foundation in health and education sector. Mr Muhammad Haider Amin in his address stressed the need for collective efforts aimed at creating awareness of the harmful effects of drugs use among the youth. TUF with collaboration of its affiliated Madinah Teaching Hospital is already taking measures for the rehabilitation of drug addicts, he added. 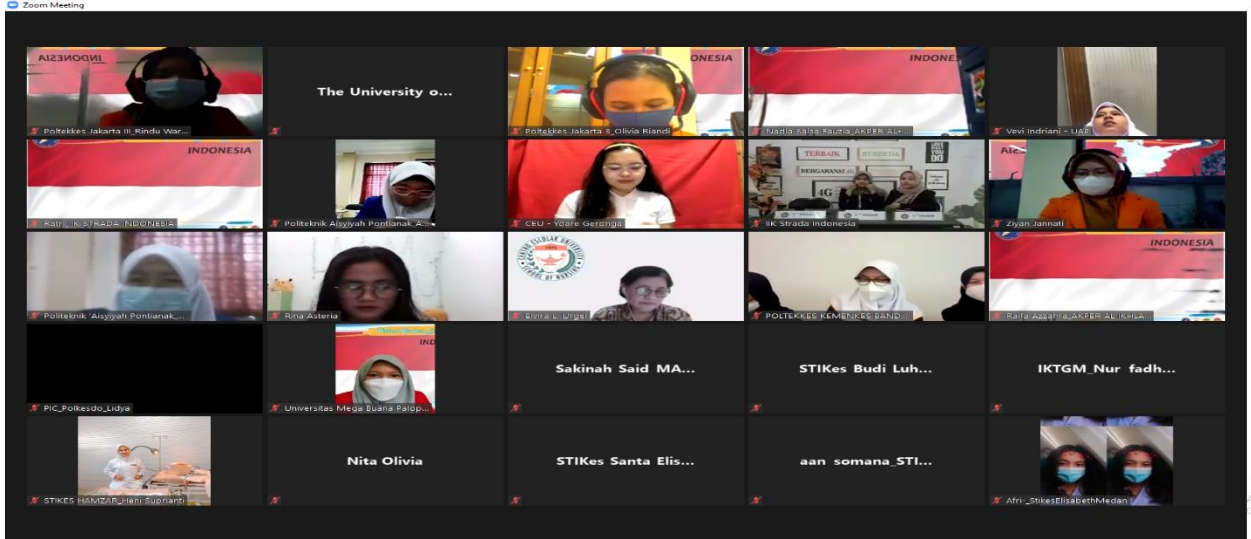
#### **10. Corporate Social Responsibility Awards 2022**

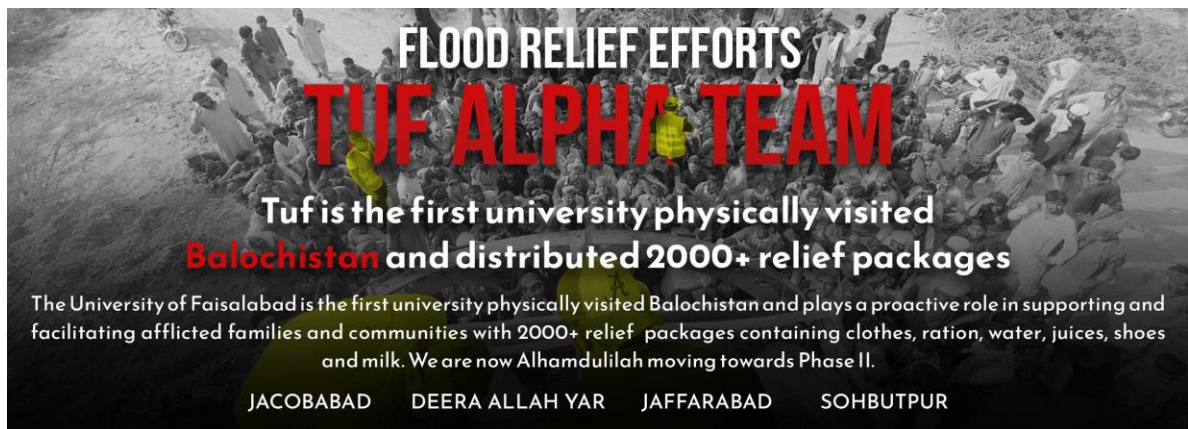
